

UNC Greensboro Suggested Degree Plan

Associate in Arts (A.A.) to Bachelor of Science (B.S.) in

Human Development & Family Studies: Child, Youth, Family Development concentration

The Associate in Arts degree shall be granted for a planned program of study consisting of a minimum of 60 semester hours of credit (SHC) of college transfer courses. Students are encouraged to complete associate degree requirements with courses that are approved for transfer through the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement (CAA).

Community college graduates must obtain a grade of "C" or better in each course and an overall GPA of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale to transfer to UNC Greensboro with a junior status.

Due to the nature of the Human Development and Family Studies curriculum, students can expect no fewer than 3 years at UNC Greensboro to complete a Bachelor of Science degree.
