

UNC Greensboro Suggested Degree Plan

Associate in Arts (A.A.) to Bachelor of Science (B.S.) in Speech Pathology & Audiology

The Associate in Arts degree shall be granted for a planned program of study consisting of a minimum of 60 semester hours of credit (SHC) of college transfer courses. Students are encouraged to complete associate degree requirements with courses that are approved for transfer through the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement (CAA).

Community college graduates must obtain a grade of "C" or better in each course and an overall GPA of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale to transfer to UNC Greensboro with a junior status.

Students must apply directly to the Communication Sciences and Disorders (CSD) Department for admission to the CSD program BY MAY 15th (fall admission only). Only students who are admitted to the program will be permitted to enroll in CSD 300+ courses at UNC Greensboro.

<p>OTHER REQUIRED HOURS (15 SHC)</p> <p>Academic Transition <i>The following course is required (1 SHC):</i> ACA 122 College Transfer Success (1 SHC)</p> <p>An additional 14 SHC of courses should be selected from courses classified as pre-major, elective or general education courses within the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement. Students should select courses based on their intended major and concentration:</p> <p>Foreign Language The student is required to complete 3 additional courses (9 SHC) for the intended major including one ASL course and one additional Foreign Language of the student’s choice (i.e.: Spanish, French, etc.). For the third course, students can take a second ASL course, or a second course in their chosen foreign language. <i>Example: ASL 111, ASL 112 and SPA 111 OR, ASL 111, SPA 111 and SPA 112:</i> <i>Select three of the following courses from two different disciplines (9 SHC)</i></p> <p>ASL 111 Elementary ASL I (required) (3 SHC) ASL 112 Elementary ASL II (3 SHC)</p> <p>111 in Additional Foreign Language (required) (3 SHC) 112 in Additional Foreign Language (3 SHC)</p>
