

UNC Greensboro Suggested Degree Plan

Associate in Arts (A.A.) to Bachelor of Science (B.S.) in Consumer, Apparel, & Retail Studies: Apparel Design Concentration

The Associate in Arts degree shall be granted for a planned program of study consisting of a minimum of 60 semester hours of credit (SHC) of college transfer courses. Students are encouraged to complete associate degree requirements with courses that are approved for transfer through the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement (CAA).

Community college graduates must obtain a grade of "C" or better in each course and an overall GPA of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale to transfer to UNC Greensboro with a junior status.

Due to the nature of the Consumer, Apparel, and Retail Studies curriculum, students can expect no fewer than 3 years at UNC Greensboro to complete a Bachelor of Science degree.

Intermediate-level Foreign Language Proficiency (12 SHC)

Select one foreign language (ie., ARA, CHI, FRE, GER, ITA, JPN, LAT, POR, RUS, or SPA) and complete 111 – 212.

Students in the Global Retail Management Emphasis are required to complete two (2) language courses at or above the 300 level. Registering for upper-level foreign language courses at UNC Greensboro will either require departmental approval, or demonstrated intermediate-level proficiency. The typical sequence to demonstrate intermediate-level proficiency is four (4) three-hour courses in one foreign language. All foreign language courses approved for transfer through the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement satisfy associate degree general education hours; therefore, it is recommended students complete their sequence as part of their associate degree program to then satisfy the concentration’s language requirement.
